### Part IV: Your Huff Scores & Interpretations

Lost Time Rate Reduction:

For every 100 FTEs, incidents that resulted in an employee suffering days away from work, because of a work-related injury or illness went from 5.97 last year to 3.91 this year.

**This is a reduction of 34.47%**

Lost Work Day Rate Reduction:

For every 100 FTEs, total work days lost because of a work-related injury or illness went from 8.96 last year to 9.13 this year.

**This is an increase of 1.93%**
