SWANA CERTIFICATION

Certification offered by SWANA is voluntary. Complete details about certification are available at:

<https://swana.org/Certification.aspx>. To be eligible for certification you must:

- Achieve a 70% or higher on the certification exam
- Meet SWANA’s minimum education and work experience requirements
- Complete an application (available on the SWANA website and at the training)

Certification applies for a period of 3 years. In order to maintain your certification, you must obtain a minimum of 30 continuing education credits (CEUs) within that time. If you are currently SWANA certified in any discipline (Recycling, Collections, Transfer, MOLO, etc) taking the recycling course will satisfy your CEU requirement for re-certification. **TCEQ credit is not available for this course.**

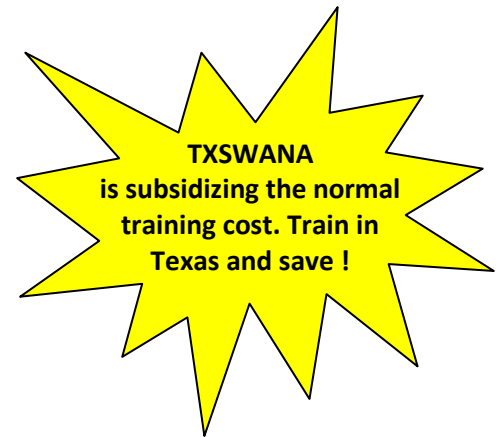
